I Am Respectful

I respect myself and others.

Teaching Examples

Example: Sam was walking down the hallway, admiring others' artwork without touching it.

Non Example: Mr. John's class was walking down the hallway talking and goofing around with each other. Mrs. Carol's class was attempting to take a test, but Mrs. Carol had to close the door because her students were so distracted by the kids in the hallway.

Example: While lining up for the lunch tunnel, the kids are excited for the lunch and recess time. Even though they're excited, they remember other classes are still learning and they choose to keep their voices quiet and hands to themselves while in the lunch tunnel.

Activity and/or Refresher to do later

1. Lunch tunnel lesson: Take numbered cards and pass them out to students. Students are to walk to their numbered sign quietly from your classroom location. (Optional: collect the cards and distribute to students again. Rearrange sign order and time students walking quickly and quietly to their numbered signs)
2. Create classroom hallway check points to make sure all students are being respectful in the hallway. Have your class practice walking to your specific checkpoints for various destinations (art, lunch, PE, etc)
