I can be counted on to do things in an honest way.

Teaching Examples

Example: The teacher asks Sam to take the lunch count down to the office. He turns it in and returns to class quickly.

Non Example: Chris and Karie are fighting over the first place in line, running in order to get in front of the other. Correction: Chris and Karie can be trusted to hold their spot in line, even if it's not the spot they wanted.

Activity and/or Refresher to do later

1. Discuss the importance of being trustworthy when you're sent in the hallway by yourself. Talk about having character and why it's important for the teacher to have trust in you.
2. Review "hot spots" where students may be sent by themselves (lunch count, office notes, etc.).
