Teaching Examples

Example: Joe cut in line at the tire swing. When asked about his actions, he admitted to what he did and took his place at the end of the line.

Non Example: Sarah reported to the recess aide that Emily was making fun of her, even though this was a lie. Correction: If Sarah was upset with Emily, she dealt with the problem herself instead of making up a lie to get Emily in trouble.

Kid Activity

1. Role-play following an adult's instructions on the playground.
2. Discuss what it means to be a good sport, even when you're losing (i.e. if you get "out" in kickball – admitting it and knowing you'll have another chance to play).

After the Lesson

Refresher

1. Have a group conversation about what problems are seen on the playground and how being trustworthy may solve some of these problems.
